



## First European Tibetan Youth Parliament Concludes Successfully

After a three-day conference, the First European Tibetan Youth Parliament has concluded successfully and approved a resolution that was officially handed over to the Tibetan Prime Minister Professor Samdhong Rinpoche as well as to Chairman of the Parliament of the Tibetan Government in Exile, Mr. Penpa Tsering.

Amongst other things, the Youth Parliament resolved to pursue the path of peaceful and non-violent resistance. Furthermore, the Parliament supports the Sino-Tibetan dialogue on three conditions:

- In the future the dialogue should be carried out accompanied by an impartial observer
- The dialogue should not take place on Chinese soil any longer.
- The Chinese side must acknowledge the existence of the Tibet Issue as an issue that has to be solved.

With the handover of the resolution and the subsequent final ceremony, the first European Tibetan Youth Parliament thus concluded. The participants also resolved to call the second European Tibetan Youth Parliament in the near future.
